

# FLOWER AND ORNAMENTAL SEED

## Including Fruiting Plant seed

### ALYSSUM 2800 s/g

(*Lobularia maritima*.) Annual. Sow September-March (cold): August-May (temp): AYR (trop). Germinates 8 days at 21-24 deg. C. in light. Superb bedding and edging plant.

**2142 - Carpet of Snow.** Pure white flowers on low spreading plants that join up to give impression of a beautiful white carpet.

Pkt: 1000 seeds: \$3.50. 5g: \$10.00.

**2143 - Rosie O'Day.** Masses of rose pink flowers on plants with a low spreading habit.

Pkt: 1000 seeds: \$3.50. 5g: \$19.30.

**2141 - Royal Carpet.** Clear violet-purple flowers on compact 8cm plants. Ideal for bedding.

Pkt: 1000 seeds: \$3.50. 5g: \$10.00.

### AMARANTHUS 1500 s/g

Annual sown in spring and early summer. Germinates 8 days at 21 deg C.

**2165 - Love-Lies-Bleeding.** (*A. caudatus*). Huge drooping purple flower spikes and attractive purple tinged foliage. Plants to 1.2m. Cultivated in some areas as a food plant with seed and leaves eaten. Packets only: 300 seeds: \$3.70.

**2167 - Viridis.** (*A. caudatus*). Attractive green drooping flowers spikes instead of the usual purple. Excellent effect when grown with the purple form. Packets only: 300 seeds: \$3.70.

### AMMI MAJUS (Queen Anne's Lace)

2200 s/g. Sow August to December directly where plants are to be grown, thinning to 40cm. apart.

**2170 - Queen Anne's Lace.** (*A. majus*). Lovely pure white flower heads made up of thousands of individual florets. Excellent as a cut flower, and sought after by cottage gardeners. Annual.

Pkt: 400 seeds: \$3.50. 5g: \$14.80.

### ANTIRRHINUM (Snapdragons)

7500 s/g. (*A. majus*). Annual. Sow September to April (cold): spring and autumn (temp): autumn to early spring (trop). Pre-chill seed in refrigerator for 3 to 4 days. Do not cover. Germinates in 2 weeks at 18 to 21 deg C.

**2200 - Colour Guard.** Mixed colours including white, yellow, pink, orange, scarlet and crimson shades. Long graceful spikes with up to 40 flowers. Height 75cm. Vigorous base branching plants. Rust resistant. Pkt: 1500 seeds: \$3.50. 5g: \$8.10.

**2202 - Snapshot Mixed.** For colour over the cool months, these beautiful Snapdragons are ideal. Huge range of colours on plants 15 to 25cm tall with a spread of up to 30cm. Ideal for containers or bedding. Packets only: 100 seeds: \$4.70.

**2204 - Tom Thumb.** Bushy compact plants 25cm. high and 30cm. across. The mixed colours give a very effective display.

Pkt: 1000 seeds: \$3.50. 5g: \$8.60.

### AQUILEGIA (Columbine) (Granny's

Bonnets). (*A. coerulea*). 800 s/g. Perennial. Sow autumn and spring (cold): autumn (temp and trop). Chill seed at 4.5 deg. C. for 4-5 days before sowing. Germinates 3-4 weeks at 21-29 deg. C. Sow very shallow, covering with vermiculite or similar.

**2220 - Mc Kana Giants.** Large long tailed flowers in a magnificent colour range including blue, pink, maroon, white and combinations. Ideal for backgrounds and cutting. Tolerates light shade. Pkt: 250 seeds: \$3.90. 5g: \$24.70.

**2221 - Songbird Hybrids.** A First Year flowering Perennial. This mix includes rose & white, lavender & white, blue, yellow, and red & white produced in late spring and early summer. Truly eye catching. Plants 30 to 40cm. Flowers typically 4 to 9 cm across. Packets only: 10 seed: \$5.60.

### ARMERIA (Sea Pink) (*A. pseudamerica*).

Perennial sown in spring & autumn, Flowers over a long period. Excellent in a border, bed or pot. Great cutflower. Expect germ. in 6 days at 18 deg.C.

**2207 - Joystick Mix.** A lovely mix producing flowers of lilac and red shades. Flowers from mid Spring to mid-Summer. Plants to 35cm, with a spread of 30cm. Packets only: 75 seed: \$3.60.

### ASTER 450 s/g

(*Callistephus chinensis*). Annual. Sow spring and early summer (cold & temp): June to Sept (trop). Germinates 8-10 days at 18-24 deg. C. Plants like warm conditions.

**2264 - King Branching.** A choice mixture of fully double blooms in a full range of colours on well-branched plants. Excellent for cut flowers. Packets only: 150 seeds: \$3.80.

**2266 - Pot n'Patio.** Dwarf early flowering plants which grow to around 15cm. Flowers 5 to 7cm across in a range of blue, pink and scarlet shades. Superb in containers, alone or in mixed plantings. Packets only: 75 seeds: \$5.50.

**2263 - Powderpuffs Bouquet Mix.** Intensely double flowers on strong 60cm stems. Excellent for both cutting and garden display. Pkt: 300 seeds: \$3.50. 10g: \$16.70.

### BEGONIA tuberous

(*B. x tuberhybrida*). Should be regarded as difficult to grow. Seed is pelleted for easier sowing and handling. *A detailed Cultural sheet is included.*

**2284 - Fortune Mix.** Spectacular showy flowers over an extended period. Plants compact and up to 25cm tall. Superb for pots, hanging baskets and window boxes. Packets only: 15 pellets: \$6.20.

### BELLIS PERENNIS 4800 s/g

Perennial. Sow in spring and autumn (cold): autumn in temperate and tropical areas, 3mm deep in seed box or outdoor seedbed, transplanting 8 weeks later.

**2300 - Pomponette Mix.** Button like double flowers on 15 cm spikes. Colours Pink, Red and White. Supplied as easy to sow pellets. Excellent in the garden or pots. Packets only: 25 seed: \$3.60.

**2300 - Monstrosum.** Compact plants with large fully double flowers. Flowers in a range of red, rose and white shades. Packets only: 1000 seeds: \$3.50.

### BELLS OF IRELAND 180 s/g

(*Molucella laevis*). Annual sown spring or autumn (cold & Temp): autumn to early spring (trop). Germinates 3 weeks at 29 deg C. days, and 10 deg. C. nights. **Hint: Pre-chill seed at 10 deg C. for 5 days before sowing.**

**2320 - Irish Green Bells.** The green bell-shaped bracts give the effect of green flowers clustered along a stalk up to 75cm tall. Can be dried. Good cut flower. Pkt: 150 seeds: \$3.50. 10g: \$17.00.

### CALENDULA (English Marigold) 120 s/g

(*C. officinalis*). Annual. Sow autumn and spring (cold): summer and autumn (temp): autumn (tropics). Germinates 7-10 days at 21 deg. C. in dark. Does well sown direct where it is to grow. Cover with 1cm soil to exclude light.

**2400 - Pacific Beauty Mixed.** A fine mix of many colours including lemon, cream and gold. Height 45cm. Stands summer heat well. Pkt: 100 seeds: \$3.00. 10g: \$21.70.

### CANARY CREEPER 15 s/g

(*Trapoleum peregrinum*). Annual. Sow spring (cold): spring and summer (temp): late summer - early spring (trop). Germinates 10 days at 18 deg. C. Best sown direct. Cover seed 1cm. Plants like semi-shade and moist soil.

**2420 - Canary Creeper.** Masses of bright yellow frilled blooms on vines to 2.5m. A graceful plant with beautiful foliage that is not grown enough. Packets only: 20 seeds: \$3.50.

### CANDYTUFT 400 s/g

(*Iberis amara*). Annual. Sow spring and autumn (cold) or late summer & autumn in other areas. Germinates 8-10 days at 21 deg. C.

**2441 - Fairy Mixed.** Dwarf compact strain in full colour range. The neat dome shaped plants grow only 20cm. tall. Excellent as a border. Pkt: 300 seeds: \$3.50. 10g: \$6.50.

### CANTERBURY BELLS 4700 s/g

Biennial. Sow very shallow in late summer and early autumn. Germinates 15 days at 21 deg. C.

**2480 - Cup and Saucer.** (*Campanula calycanthemata*). A Cup and Saucer type in a range of colours. Flower spikes to 80cm. Very eye catching. Pkt: 700 seeds: \$3.50. 5g: \$20.90.

### CARNATION 550 s/g

(*Dianthus caryophyllus*). Perennial best sown autumn (cold and temp): autumn to early spring (trop). Germinates 2 - 3 weeks at 21 deg C.

**2520 - Chabaud Giant.** A good mix of colours, the fragrant double blooms make excellent cut flowers. Stems up to 45cm. long. Pkt: 200 seeds: \$3.50. 5g: \$17.00.

**2521 - Fragrance Dwarf.** Mixed colours. Small carnation flowers that are highly perfumed. The neat plants make an excellent border. Packets only: 100 seeds: \$3.50.

### CELOSIA 1400 s/g

Annual, best sown August to November. Can be sown directly or transplanted. Germinates in 2 weeks at 25 deg C.

**2545 - Coral Gardens.** (*C. cristata*). Cockscomb. Large brightly coloured combs on 30cm. plants. Expect colours of crimson, red, rose and orange. Pkt: 200 seeds: \$3.90. 1g: \$12.20.

**2546 - Century Mixed.** (*C. plumosa*). Easily grown and early flowering, the 60cm plants produce large plumes up to 20cm long in a range of red, pink, and yellow shades. Ideal for taller garden beds, large containers and as a cut flower. Packets only: 70 seeds: \$3.90.

### CINERARIA

(*Senecio cruentus*). Annual, best sown late summer and autumn. Do not cover seed and water with tepid water for germination in 10 days at 21 - 24 deg C.

**2581 - Corsage.** Excellent colour range with large flowers. Plants to 45cm. Loves light shade. Packets only: 100 seeds: \$5.30.

**2582 - Masquerade.** Dwarf version of Corsage. Plants 25 to 30cm in an excellent colour range. Packets only: 100 seeds: \$3.70.

**CLEOME (Spider Flower) 700 s/g.** Annual sown spring and summer (cold & temp): autumn and winter (trop). Germinates in 12 days at 26 deg C.

**2620 - Mixed.** (*C. spinosa*). To 1 metre tall, this easily grown plant has trusses of pink, white or rose flowers. Excellent bedding or background plant. Easily grown and flowers for months. Pkt: 600 seeds: \$3.50. 10g: \$18.10

**COBAEA** (Cathedral Bells) 20 s/g. Perennial climber, although often grown as an annual. Sow spring 1cm deep for germination in 2 weeks at 18 deg C.

**2640 - Cathedral Bells Purple.** (*C. scandens.*) Flowers first year from seed. Grows to 4 metres tall with large purple Cup and Saucer flowers. Pkt: 10 seeds: \$5.80. 5g: \$37.40.

**COLEUS** 3400 s/g  
(*C. blumei*). Perennial. Sow extremely shallow August to December. Germinates 10 days at 18 - 24 deg C. Water with warm water.

**2680 - Rainbow Mixed.** Superb strain of the tall Rainbow type with beautiful foliage. Plants 30 to 45cm tall with bright rich colouring. Excellent in pots. Packets only: 250 seeds: \$4.80.

**CORNFLOWER** 220 s/g  
(*Centaurea cyanus*). Sow autumn and spring (cold): late summer and autumn (temp & trop). Germinates 10 days in dark at 15 deg C. Superb annual cut flower to 80cm.

**2700 - Polka Dot Mix.** Much shorter and manageable than the older types growing to around 40cm. Full range of all cornflower colours.

**2701 - Double Mixture.** Excellent colour range including blues, pinks, maroon, white and red.

**2702 - Blue Boy.** Bright Cornflower blue.

Also available in individual colours.

**2702A - White, 2702B - Black (Deep Maroon), 2702C - Mauve, 2702E - Pink.**

Each of the above Cornflowers:

Pkt: 500 seeds: \$3.50. 10g: \$6.50.

**COSMOS** 140 - 200 s/g  
(*C. bipinnatus*). Annual germinating 5 days at 21 deg C. Sow spring to midsummer (cold & temp): late winter - mid spring (trop). Early sowings produce shorter plants. Easily grown.

**2723 - Klondyke Bright Lights.** Brilliant semi double flowers in shades of red, gold and orange. Plants to 70cm. Quite distinct from regular varieties. Packets only: 250 seeds: \$3.50.

**2722 - Purity White.** Pure white form of Sensation. Pkt: 90 seeds: \$3.50. 10g: \$6.80.

**2724 - Seashells Mixed.** Fluted petals give the impression of a collection of Seashells. Good colour range on 90cm. plants. Unique and decorative. Pkt: 50 seeds: \$3.50. 10g: \$16.20.

**2720 - Sensation.** Mixed pinks, mauves and whites. Early flowering on plants to a metre tall. Excellent in any garden. Pkt: 90 seeds: \$3.50. 10g: \$6.80.

**CUPHEA.** (Cigar Plant)

(*C. ignea*). Prefers bright sun but tolerant of some shade, likes moisture, tolerant of short dry spells. Easily grown from seed sown in spring.

**2738 - Dynamite.** Small perennial covered with small tubular, bright scarlet flowers over dark green foliage. It is well suited to containers or garden. Plants grow only 25cm high, with a spread of 30cm. Packets only: 10 seed: \$4.70.

**DAHLIA**

(*Dahlia variabilis*). Perennial. Dahlias are straightforward to grow from seed. They will flower twelve weeks from sowing until first frosts. Superb as a cut flower and excellent for creating a statement in displays and herbaceous borders. They are particularly useful for filling in gaps that appear as other plants go to seed. Seed-raised Dahlias flower well especially towards the autumn. They are generally treated as annuals though they produce a tuber to survive the winter, which can be dug up, stored and replanted the following year. Sow 2cm deep in spring. Expect germination in 10 days at 18 to 20 deg C.

**2741 - Cactus Mixed.** A nicely balanced mixture of the spiky cactus flowered types, perfect for cutting and colour. Grows to around a metre. Packets only: 50 seeds: \$3.50.

**2742 - Pompom Double Mix.** A tall-growing dahlia mix producing pompom flowers in a range of different colours. Ideal for making a splash of colour in the border or bedding display during the summer months. Packets only: 50 seeds: \$3.50.

**2740 - Figaro Mixed.** Ideal for borders or containers, the 40cm plants produce mainly double flowers in a wide colour range. Packets only: 30 seeds: \$3.80.

**DELPHINIUM** 450 s/g  
(*D. elatum*). Sow this perennial in spring and autumn (cold): autumn to mid winter (temp & trop). Germinates 18 - 21 days at 26 - 30 deg C. with light excluded. Pre-chill by mixing with damp sand and placing in refrigerator 4 days before sowing.

**2761 - Magic Fountains Mixed.** A shorter variety with an excellent colour range. Spikes 60 to 90cm, making it a better choice for windy or small gardens. Packets only: 50 seeds: \$4.20.

**2760 - Pacific Giants Mixed.** A large double flowered strain in a wide range of colours. Spikes over a metre tall. Packets only: 50 seeds: \$4.20.

**DIANTHUS**

(*D. chinensis*). Sow spring and autumn (cold & temp), autumn into early spring in the tropics. Germinates in 7 days at 21 deg C. *Hint: Chill in refrigerator 4 days before sowing.*

**2780 - Baby Doll Mixed.** Very dwarf 15cm plants and a good range of colours. Excellent for containers and edging. Packets only: 250 seeds: \$3.50.

**2781 - Dynasty Hybrids Mixed.** The world's first F1 double Dianthus. They are very well-branched, upright and strong-stemmed. Plants perform very well in the garden with good heat tolerance. The 40-50cm plants are ideal for cutting The bright, 2.5-3cm blooms are lightly scented. Packets only: 40 seed: \$4.00.

**DICHONDRA**

**2800 - D. repens.** (Kidney Weed). Low growing prostrate perennial used as a lawn substitute, especially between pavers etc. or in shaded positions. Leaves kidney shaped to 1cm. across. Also makes an attractive plant for hanging baskets. 100 grams sows 20 sq. metres. 25g: \$7.50. 100g: \$20.00. 250g: \$45.00.

**2802 - Silver Falls.** This superb seed grown foliage

plant is covered with small, rounded, silver leaves on silver stems. Sow very shallow and expect germination in 4 to 5 days at 24 deg.C. It has a true cascading habit, (up to 1.2 metres), making it an excellent choice for mixed containers or as a single hanging basket item. Can be used as a low growing ground cover. Very heat and drought-tolerant. Packets only: 8 seed: \$6.40.

**ECHINACEA** 300 s/g

A hardy perennial best sown in spring or autumn where plants are to be grown. Expect germination in 3 weeks at 23 deg C.

**2810 - Purple Coneflower.** (*E. purpurea*). Highly valued as a medicinal herb, but equally valued as an outstanding ornamental. Plants to 80cm with 7cm pink/purple flowers and a prominent cone. Very Hardy. Packets only: 75 seeds: \$3.50.

**ECHINOPS** (Blue Globe Thistle)

Sow July to October for germination in 2 weeks at 20 deg C. Perennial.

**2815 - Ritro.** (*E. ritro*). Round steel blue flower heads on 1.2 metre stems. An excellent cut flower. Flowers in late summer.

Packets only: 35 seeds: \$4.50.

ESCHSCHOLZIA - See Poppies (Californian).

**EUPHORBIA** 60 s/g

Sun loving annual. Can be sown direct or as seedlings and transplanted 30cm apart. Seed germinates in 1 to 2 weeks at 21 deg C.

**CAUTION.** Sap and pollen may cause irritations to eyes and skin in some people.

**2830 - Snow Top.** (*E. marginata*). Plants to over 1 metre with variegated white and green tips. Ideal as a background or massing plant, and as cut foliage. Pkt: 50 seeds: \$3.50. 10g: \$16.90.

**FOXGLOVE**

(*Digitalis purpurea*). Biennial sown late winter and autumn. Germinates 2 - 3 weeks at 21 deg C. Press seed into soil (don't cover). Keep moist.

2840 - Excelsior. Improved form and shades on tall stems to 1.5 metres. Excellent in any background situation. Mixed shades. Packets only: 1000 seeds: \$3.50.

2841 - Foxy Mixed. A shorter Foxglove with stems to 90cm. Upright habit. Flowers in rose, lavender, cream, yellow and white. Suits windy and smaller gardens. Packets only: 1000 seeds: \$3.50.

**GAILLARDIA (Blanket Flower)**

Sow spring & autumn (cold & temp): March to Oct (trop). Sow very shallow, ensuring soil is at least 16 deg C. 270 s/g

**2880 - Grandiflora.** (*G. grandiflora*). Excellent large flowered mixture in a full colour range. Perennial to 75cm. Withstands hot and dry conditions well. Packets only: 100 seeds: \$3.50.

**GAZANIA**

(*Gazania splendens*). Hardy carpeting perennial sown spring and early summer for flowering from the following winter. Exclude light until seed germinates in 10 days at 21 deg C.

**2900 - Sunshine Hybrids.** Large flowers in shades of bronze, salmon, red and orange, many with dark centres. Stems to 20cm. Must have full sun and excellent drainage. Packets only: 40 seeds: \$4.20.

**GODETIA**

(*G. grandiflora*). Annual best grown in a sunny position with shelter from strong winds. Sow spring (cold): autumn in other areas.

**2970 - Double Tall.** Double flowering tall mixture of brilliant colours. Up to 75cm. tall.

Packets only: 1000 seeds: \$3.90.

**GOMPHREMA**

Soak seeds in water prior to sowing. Best grown in spring in full sun in a well-drained soil. Easily grown.

**2967 - Buddy Series Mixed.** (*G. globosa*). Blooms through hot, dry conditions; flowering until frost. Plants grow to around 20cm tall with a similar spread. Flowers of purple, rose and white. Excellent as a dried or cut flower. Packets only: 75 seed: \$3.50.

**GYPSOPHILA** (Baby's Breath). 1200 s/g.

Sow late winter to autumn (cold): February to November in other areas. Germinates 10 days at 21 - 27 deg C, growing on at lower temperatures.

**2983 - Snowflake Double White.** (*G. paniculata* "Snowflake"). Flowers are tiny pure white balls (up to 60% double) on 75cm. stems. Ideal for bouquets, florists and for drying. Perennial. Pkt: 400 seeds: \$3.50. 5g: \$25.00.

## HELICHRYSUM (Everlasting Strawflowers)

1200 s/g. Annual sown in spring and autumn (cold and temp): late summer and winter (trop). Australian native. Germinates 7 days at 21 deg. C. in light. **3000 - Monstrosum.** (*H. bracteatum cv.*). Double flowers in an excellent mix of colours. Grows to 90cm. tall and flowers freely. Excellent fresh or dried. Pkt: 400 seeds: \$3.50. 10g: \$20.10.

**3001 - Tom Thumb Dwarf Double Mixed.** (*H. bracteatum cv.*). Free flowering over a long period. 45cm high. A good range of colours. Packets only: 400 seeds: \$3.50.

## HOLLYHOCK 110 s/g

(*Althaea rosea*). Sow In autumn. If not sown where to mature, transplant before taproot goes down. Germinates 3 weeks at 15 deg C. soil temp. **Hint:** *Seed may benefit from chilling.*

**3080 - Chaters Double Show Mixed.** Best form and colour range available. Fully double flowers up to 10cm. across. Plants up to 2 metres tall. Biennial. Pkt: 90 seeds: \$3.90. 5g: \$10.10.

**3081 - Queeny Mix.** Annual, suitable for bedding and borders. Plants only 50cm tall, bushy, and base branching. Plants full double flowers. Excellent colour range. Packets only: 40 seeds: \$3.70.

## HONESTY 50 s/g

(*Lunaria annua*). Biennial. Sow autumn and spring (cold and temp): autumn (trop).

**3100 - Mixed.** Flower stems to 1 metre. Grown for its flat decorative seed pods which are used for decoration and dried arrangements. Rose or white flowers. Pkt: 55 seeds: \$3.50. 10g: \$8.00.

## IMPATIENS

Prefers part shade. Sow August to February, covering with 3mm of a mix of peat and vermiculite. Germinates in 2 weeks at 24 deg C. *Detailed cultural notes provided.*

**3152 - Super Elfin Mix.** (*Impatiens hawkerii*). Large flowers (typically 3cm across), in an excellent colour range on compact base branching plants. Packets only: 20 seeds: \$5.90.

## LARKSPUR (Annual Delphinium) 450 s/g.

(*Delphinium consolida*). Sow autumn and early spring (cold): late summer and autumn elsewhere. Germinates in 3 weeks at 13 deg. C. Covering with 2 to 4mm soil. Keep dark. In hot weather chill seed for 4-5 days at 7-10 deg. C.

**3180 - Supreme.** Gives a beautiful spike about 1 to 1.5 metres tall. Includes a good range of colours. Cool weather favours good germination and vigorous growth. Pkt: 100 seeds: \$3.50. 5g \$12.00.

## LIATRIS

Perennial. Sow late summer and early autumn into a good soil with temperature of around 21 deg. C. where it will germinate in around 2 - 3 weeks.

**Hint:** *Sow directly where plants are to be grown, after refrigerating the seed for 72 hours.*

**3210 - Blazing Star.** (*L. spicata*). Beautiful long deep purple flower spikes up to 70cm. tall. Very hardy and an excellent cut flower and a cottage garden favourite. Packets only: 75 seeds: \$3.50.

## LINARIA 15,000 s/g

Annual. Sow seed 1mm deep in spring and autumn (cold): late summer and autumn in other areas.

**3220 - Fairy Bouquet.** (*L. maroccana*). Mixed colours. Dwarf 25cm plants. Good for border and rock gardens. The tiny snapdragon like flowers include shades of crimson, pink, mauve, gold and rose. Pkt: 2000 seeds: \$3.50. 5g: \$10.10.

## LISIANTHUS (Eustoma or Prairie Gentian)

(*Eustoma grandiflora*). Annual or Biennial. Very long-lasting cut flower. Must be sown on the surface for germination in 2 weeks at 20 to 25 deg C. soil temperature. Grow in a controlled environment.

Detailed Cultural sheet included with each packet. Should be regarded as difficult to grow. Seed is pelleted for easier sowing and handling.

Available only in individual colours. **3241 - White, 3242 - Blue, 3243 - Yellow, 3245 - Lavender, 3247- Champagne.** Packets only: 25 pellets: \$4.00.

## LOBELIA

(*L. erinus*). Annual sown in autumn and spring (cold), autumn in other areas. Ideal long flowering plant for bedding, edging, window boxes and hanging baskets. Germinates 20 days at 21 deg. C.

**3261 - Cambridge Blue.** Superb mixture of light and violet blues. Packets only: 2000 seeds: \$3.50.
